Founded in 1915, Citrus College is in Glendora in the foothills of the San Gabriel Mountains, approximately 25 miles northeast of metropolitan Los Angeles. Classes are offered on a 16-week calendar (fall and spring semesters), as well as in a variety of non-traditional scheduling options: six-week winter intersession, evenings, late start and early end, summer sessions and optional class formats, such as distance education online courses and distance education integrated classes.
