## 2016 - 2017 FINANCIAL AID STUDENT BUDGETS (Cost of Attendance)

The following standard student budgets (Cost of Attendance) have been accepted for the use of the college in determining student's *financial need*.

Cost of Attendance **minus** Expected Family Contribution (EFC) = *financial need*

Once a student meets all the eligibility requirements for financial aid, the Financial Aid Office will determine how much financial aid a student can receive based on a student's *financial need* and the availability of funds.

Every student is expected to contribute towards their own educational expenses. **NO STUDENT SHOULD EXPECT THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE TO BE ABLE TO FUND THEIR ENTIRE NEED.**

Financial aid is considered supplemental funding necessary to meet the added expenses of attending college.
