- Completed application. Please sign and date.
- \$40 application fee (U.S. dollars). Bank check, international money order/bank draft.
- Official transcripts (high school, university, college) with official English translation.
- Official TOEFL score report (minimum 450 paper test, 133 computer test or 45 internet based test).
Not required for Intensive English Option.
- Health form—must have tuberculosis test results dated within 6 months of application.
- Affidavit of Support or notarized letter from your sponsor and official bank statement showing sufficient funds in a bank account to cover total educational and living expenses for one year. This amount must be a minimum of \$13,500 U.S. dollars for College Option Program and \$15,500 for Intensive English Option. The bank statement should be dated within 30 days of your I-20 application.

Applicants currently in the USA must submit all of the above, and in addition:

- Transfer eligibility form/SEVIS release
- Copy of passport & visa
- Copy of I-94 (both sides)
- Copy of previous school's I-20
- Photo (passport size picture of yourself)
