Five Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is there a student graduation rehearsal?

A: No. However, our team prepared a [five minute YouTube video](#) to help you prepare and know what to expect on graduation day. Please review these instructions carefully.

Q: Are tickets required for my friends and family?

Q: What time do I need to arrive?

A: Check in begins at 7:45 a.m. Please arrive and check in by 8 a.m. The ceremony begins promptly at 9 a.m. Spiked heels are **NOT** allowed, as they damage the stadium turf and all-weather track. Platform shoes are an acceptable alternative. Proper footwear is required to participate in commencement.
